The Grand Award winners in the Senior Division from this state-level fair will be selected to compete at the Virtual Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair (RISEF) taking place in May 2022.

- Individuals with 2+ years of experience in a STEM or related field
- Individuals with 2 years of college credit in a STEM field
- Individuals who hold an associates, bachelors, masters, or doctorate degree
- We are especially looking for individuals with advanced degrees and experience to judge the senior division.

SERVE AS A GENERAL VOLUNTEER

Even though AzSEF will be held virtually this year, we still 75-100 volunteers. Volunteer opportunities include

- Display & Safety- responsibilities include reviewing projects prior to the beginning of AzSEF to ensure they adhere to specific guidelines.
- Interview Room Monitor- responsibilities include joining judging interviews to help mitigate audio or video concerns and to monitor interactions between the students and judges. Individuals with Fingerprint Clearance Cards are encouraged to volunteer in this role!
